PUBLIC NOTICE
of WETLAND INVOLVEMENT

DIMOND BOULEVARD, Jewel Lake Rd to New Seward Highway
F-M-0516(1), RS-0520(11), F-M-0520(1)

Pursuant to Presidential Executive Order 11990, Protection of Wetlands, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities provides notice of proposal to place approximately 43,300 cubic yards of excavated material in the wetlands adjacent to the proposed improvement of Dimond Boulevard combined Projects F-M-0516(1), RS-5020(11), F-M-0520(1). Fill will be placed on the north side of the facility, 4,722 c.y. at the Campbell Creek crossing and the balance between Minnesota Drive and Arctic Boulevard in Anchorage, Alaska. This material is required for widening the roadway from 24 feet to 96 feet and to meet Federal Aid Highway Standards. Placement of clean granular fill material on adjacent wetlands will not alter local drainage characteristics and will not alter the water elevation in the wetlands.

A draft environmental document containing more specific information is available upon request at the address listed below. Comments and requests for specific information concerning wetland involvement should be directed to the same address. Substantive wetland comments will be incorporated into the environmental document, and must be received by January 4, 1982.
