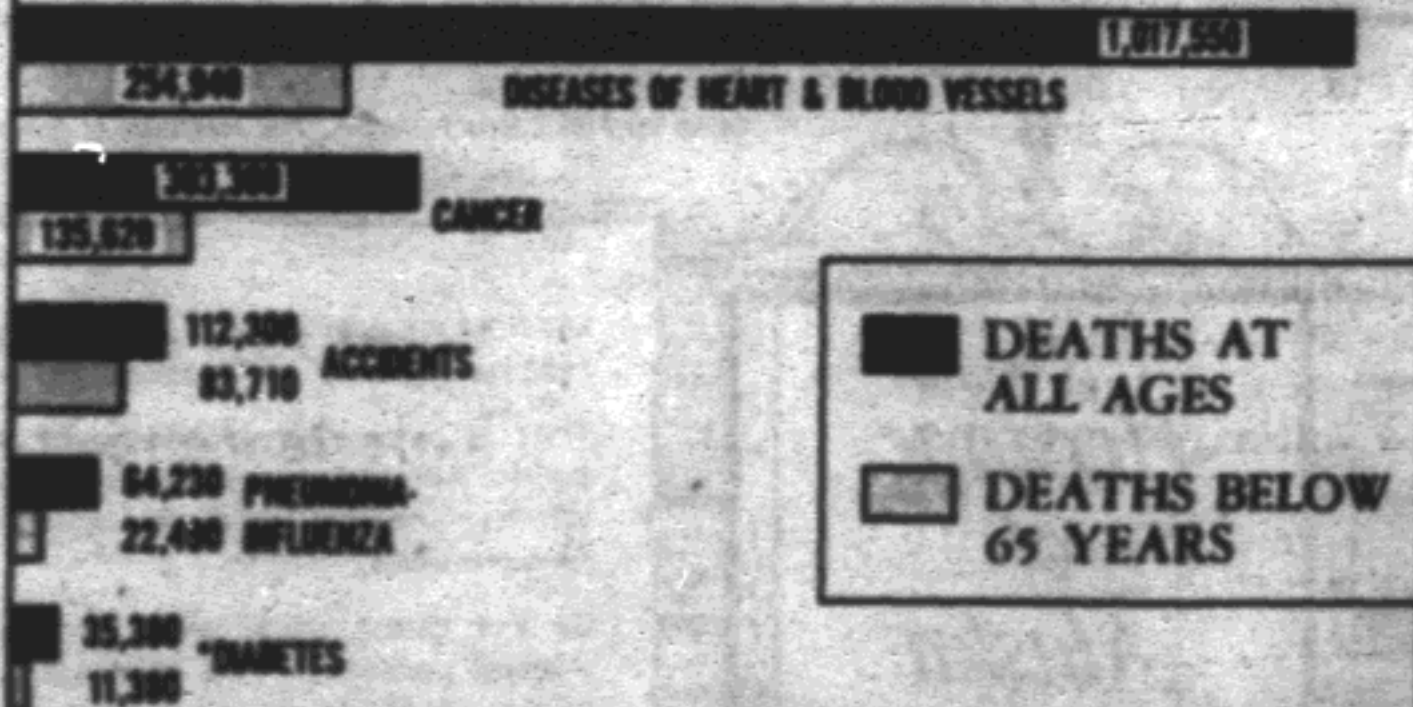


U.S. Heart and Blood Vessel Deaths Top 1-Million Toll First Time Ever

NEWEST STATISTICS on leading causes of death in the United States show that the toll from diseases of the heart and blood vessels approximated 1,017,550 in 1966—last year for which figures are available.
