

OCS impact study hearing set

The Interior Department will hold a public hearing on July 8 and 9, 1981, on the draft supplemental environmental impact statement concerning a proposed accelerated oil and gas leasing schedule. Copies of the draft are available from the BLM Alaska OCS Office on a first-come, first-serve basis.

In announcing the details of the public hearing, which will be held at the International Banquet House, 549 W. International

al Road, Anchorage, Esther, C. Wunnicke, manager of the BLM Alaska Outer Continental Shelf Office, emphasized that the hearing record will be open for written comments through July 27, 1981.

The document, just released, discusses the proposal announced by Secretary James Watt in April. In draft form, it is a supplement to the 5-Year final Environmental Impact Statement.
