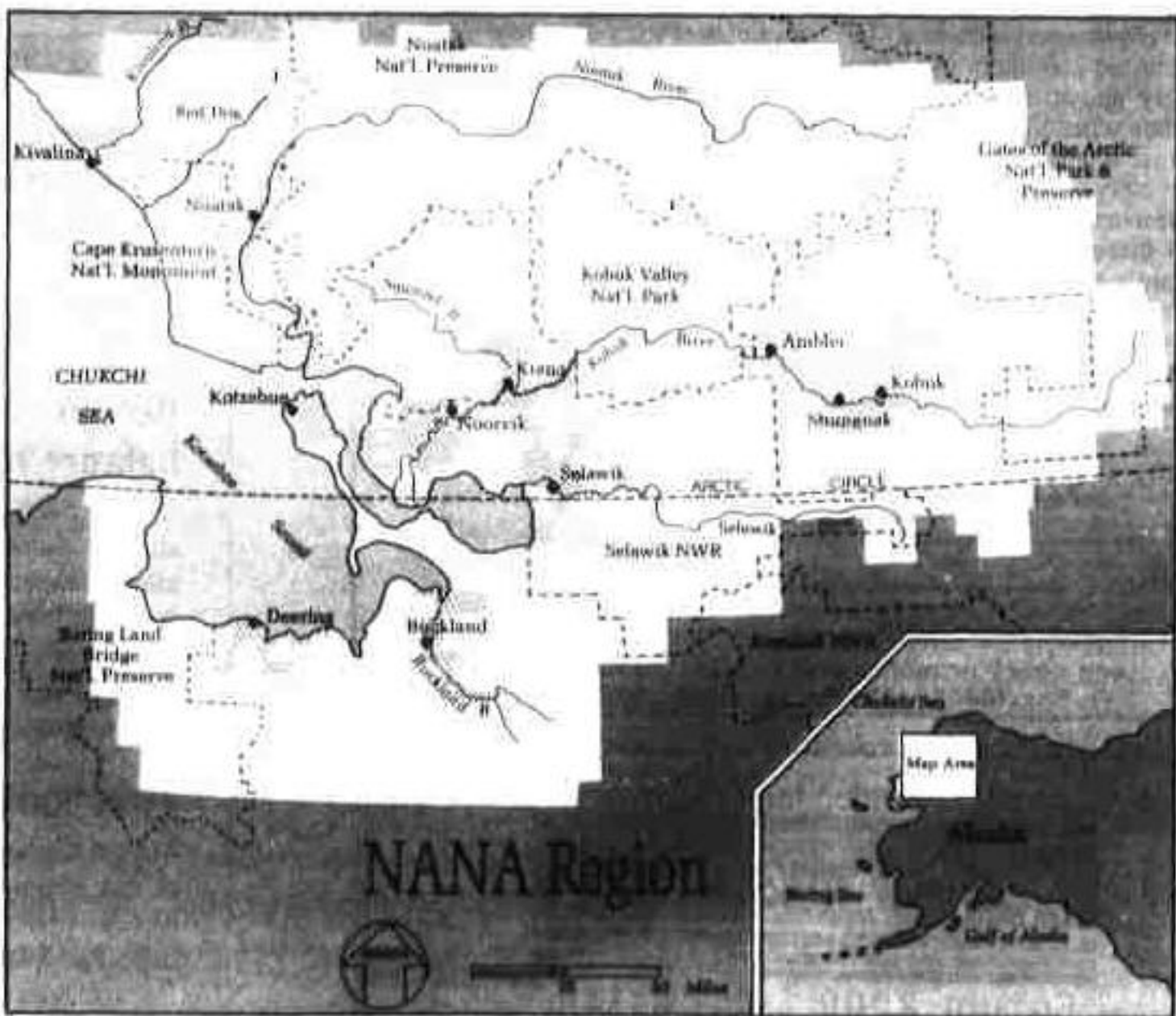


NOTICE

The Cook Inlet Housing Authority is accepting Applications from eligible families for participation in our **MUTUAL HELP HOMEOWNERSHIP OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM (MH PROGRAM)**. The MH Program enables low to moderate income "Indian" families the opportunity to acquire a home they may not have been able to acquire otherwise.

To be eligible the applicant must meet the income limits set by HUD, be able to meet the payment, utilities and maintenance of the home and be certified Alaska Native or American Indian by a State, Federal or Tribal Government.
