STATE OF ALASKA NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY & REGIONAL AFFAIRS AND THE DIVISION OF HOUSING ASSISTANCE

As required by AS 44.62.250, notice is hereby given that, under the authority of AS 44.67.360-365, the Department of Community & Regional Affairs, adopted on this date, January 9, 1981, as emergency regulations, Chapter 95 of Title 19 of the Alaska Administrative Code, relating to the nonconfirming housing program. Under this program, the Division of Housing Assistance will purchase loans made for the purpose of enabling borrowers to purchase minimum building standards under state and federal housing purchase programs, to renovate or improve such housing, or to purchase building materials for use on such housing. The regulations set forth loan requirements and terms, and areas covered include the following:

1. Borrower eligibility;
2. Maximum principal loan amounts and loan to value ratios;
3. Acceptable security for loans;
4. Maximum loan term;
5. Insurance requirements;
6. Establishment of interest rates;
7. Certification and inspection requirements;
8. Minimum health and safety standards;
9. Seller/service guide and loan applications;
10. Completion of loan;
11. Loan allocation regions;
12. Uses to which the loans may be put;
