

Coast Guard Cadet nominees sought

The U.S. Coast Guard Academy is accepting and processing the applications of Alaska students for appointments as cadets in the academy's Class of 1986.

Appointments of cadets are made solely on the basis of nationwide academic competition, without geographic or other quotas.

Applications from interest-

ed students must be submitted to the Director of Admissions, U.S. Coast Guard Academy, prior to Dec. 15.

To qualify, an applicant must be unmarried at the time of appointment, have no legal obligations resulting from a prior marriage and must have reached the age of 17, but not of 22, by July 1, 1982.
