

Alaska's Population and School Enrollments Published by ISEGR

FAIRBANKS—"Alaska's Population and School Enrollments" is the title of the latest Review of Business and Economic Conditions published by the University of Alaska's Institute of Social, Economic and Government Research. This report based on 1970 census data is the first of a new series to be published by the institute, designated by the U.S. Census Bureau as a Census Summary Computer Tape Processing Center for Alaska. Data was compiled by Peter C. Lin. The institute is utilizing the summary tapes provided by the bureau both for institute research and to fill requests for census information from public agencies and private sources. The new 48-page review was prepared in connection with work undertaken by the institute for the Alaska Higher Education Facilities Commission.
