

James Brooks Resigns State Fish And Game Post

James W. Brooks, Acting Director of the Division of Game in the State Fish and Game Department, has tendered his resignation effective September 15, today, according to an announcement by Urban C. Nelson, Commissioner of the Department.

"Mr. Brooks had agreed to stay on and assist with the transition until a new Director was appointed," the Commissioner said. "While a new Director has not yet been selected, Mr. Brooks has fulfilled his commitment and we are grateful for his help."

Commissioner Nelson said Don H. Strode, Federal Aid Coordinator for the Division of Game since 1962, will serve as Acting Director.

Brooks was employed by the Department as Director of the Division of Game in 1957 and has served in that capacity since then.
