

# Corps Officials to Assist in Rehabilitation of Fairbanks

Two top Corps officials, W. G. Sutton and S. Halverson, will visit Alaska for an indefinite period beginning September 15, today.

Mr. Sutton is Chief of the Flood Plain Management Services, Office of the Chief of Engineers in Washington, D. C., while Mr. Halverson holds that title with the Corps' North Pacific Division in Portland.

In addition to discussing flood plain management in general, the two experts will go to Fairbanks this afternoon to assist in the rehabilitation of that city.

They will be accompanied to Fairbanks by two members of the Alaska District: Mason D. Wade, Jr., Chief of the Flood Plain Management Services, and Thomas H. ("Jiggs") Tice.
