

ASES Expands For Bush Jobs

The Alaska State Employment Service is expanding its staff to provide increased services in the outlying areas of the state.

"We hope to hire several new employment interviewers and vocational counselors who are Alaska residents acquainted with the economy and employment problems of the rural areas," said Labor Commissioner Thomas J. Moore.

"They will fill a long standing gap between centralized State Employment Service Offices and outlying communities. Individuals hired for these new positions will provide manpower services including job and occupational training information and job placement assistance."

Qualifications for these positions are high school graduation or equivalent and two years of office experience. Salaries range from \$557 to \$820 per month.
