

# Canada Starts Road Care

On April 14, at the end of the day shift, Canadian Department of Highway men on the 50 mile section of the Haines Cut-Off that lies in British Canadian representatives from Whitehorse met with Alaska's men to complete the smooth transition. Equipment and supplies had started moving out a few days earlier, and by the evening of the 14th, the transfer was complete, and the road was in good condition.
