Dear Fellow Alaskans:

This is an invitation to individuals or organizations to submit a statement on the ballot measure that will appear on the August 26 Primary Election Ballot -- Free Conference Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 644, "An Act creating the Alaska Statehood Commission: and providing for an effective date."

A handout prepared by the Division of Elections regarding this ballot measure will be available to interested persons at various locations throughout the State in early August. In a manner similar to that of the Official Election Pamphlet (which is prepared for the General Election only), this handout will include a neutral summary of FCCSB 644 prepared by the Legislative Affairs Agency, a statement by persons or organizations supporting the proposition and a statement by persons or organizations opposing the proposition. Although I have already contacted the legislative opponents and supporters of this measure, I am seeking additional opinions from other informed persons or organizations.

Each statement must be typewritten, double-spaced and no longer than 500 words. Due to the review procedure and printing deadline, I must request receipt in my office of this material by Monday, July 21.

A selection process will result in the printing of one supporting statement and one opposing statement for this proposition. The author's name (and organization, if applicable) will appear in the handout.
