

\$10 Million Increase—

License Revenues

JUNEAU—Revenues from licenses and taxes collected by the Department of Revenue over the last fiscal year increased by \$10,348,642.50 which represents a 11.45 percent gain in total gross collections.

Sport fishing and hunting licenses accounted for \$1,544,056.50 of this income; Commercial fish, vessel and gear licenses for \$527,466; commercial fisherman's (residence) license, \$235,650, and out of state commercial, \$205,170.

Sport fishing and hunting revenues showed an increase of \$41,864.36, but the commercial fishing business was down from the year before. Licenses for fishing vessels and gear dropped \$39,964.75.

Resident commercial licenses were off \$8,110 and out-staters \$15,330 than last year.
