PUBLIC NOTICE

DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SITING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES IN ALASKA (18 AAC 63) ARE EFFECTIVE AS OF MARCH 31, 1989

These regulations found in 18 AAC 63 pertain to the siting of facilities that treat, store, and dispose of hazardous waste and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB). Facilities regulated by these requirements include but are not limited to:

Hazardous waste and PCB incinerators.

2. Hazardous waste underground injection wells.

3. Hazardous waste and PCB landfills.

 Hazardous waste treatment facilities that will render waste non hazardous or less hazardous.

Hazardous waste storage facilities that hold large amounts of wastes prior to shipment for treatment or disposal.

The siting regulations do not apply to generators of hazardous waste except for those generators that produce large amounts of waste and also store waste for an extended time or also treat or dispose of waste on site.
