

# *Award winner brings 'Raven' back to life*

*Raven*, by Juneau artist Dale Burlison DeArmond, is the winner of the 1987 award for fine Western book design and printing, presented by the Rounce & Coffin Club of Los Angeles.

As a winner, *Raven* will join other Western books in an exhibit that will travel to more than 40 public and private libraries throughout the United States during a two-year tour.

The book was published by Alaska Northwest Publishing. It is a presentation of tales about Raven, the wily trickster of Indian oral history. It combines stories with wood-block prints.

"The story of the Raven has come from the dim past, but the descendants of Raven are still with us, especially out in the villages — great, black lordly rogues, strolling on the beaches, gossiping on the rooftops, conferring on the docks," DeArmond said.
