Two weeks ago, the Tundra Times published an editorial entitled "An Obvious Lack of Concern" regarding the activities of a Ketchikan Community College archaeologist, Chris Rabich-Campbell.

The article was critical of Ms. Rabich-Campbell's techniques and concern about Native remains found in the national forest near Ketchikan. The editorial was based on a correction written by the Associated Press in which the Associated Press quoting Ms. Rabich-Campbell as saying she had not nor did she need to consult with representatives of Native organizations before removing remains from the forest.
