

Hoonah Grant For Airport

JUNEAU — The southeast Alaska Tlingit community of Hoonah has been awarded a \$7,216 Rural Development Agency grant, Gov. Walter J. Hickel announced.

The grant will provide wages for Hoonah men working on a town airport. Also involved in the construction of the airport are the Alaska Department of Public Works, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Alaska Airlines and local civic and government organizations.

Hoonah, a town of about 900 persons, is 45 miles southwest of Juneau.
