INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING RESOLUTIONS TO THE AFN CONVENTION GENERAL INFORMATION:

Resolutions may be submitted by any Alaska Native individual, group or organization for consideration by the delegates to the AFN convention. In order for your resolution to be given careful and complete consideration use the established process.

DEADLINE: All resolutions for the 1986 annual convention must be submitted to AFN by 12 noon, Monday, October 13, 1986.

Resolutions will not be accepted from the floor of the convention.

Do not wait and bring in your resolution with you when you come to the convention.

CRITERIA TO BE USED BY THE RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

— ONLY issues of statewide or broader significance will be considered by the resolutions committee.

— Regional and local concerns may be referred to the AFN Board of Directors, or to an appropriate regional or local organization.

— Resolutions requesting legal action or participation may be referred to the AFN Board of Directors.

— Commendations or recognition or organization, association or groups, must be supported by written information.

— If the resolution does not follow established format it may be referred back to the sponsor to be rewritten or may be rewritten by the AFN Resolutions Committee
