

ASRC, Brown & Root, form joint venture

ANCHORAGE, Alaska — Arctic Slope Regional Corporation and Brown & Root U.S.A., Inc., have announced the formation of a joint venture to pursue construction contracts on the North Slope of Alaska. The newly organized company will operate under the name Arctic Slope/Brown & Root, J.V., according to H. C. Hunt, manager of business development for Brown & Root's operations.
