

Yakutat utility storage building

The Federal Aviation Administration has issued an invitation for bids to build a utility/storage building at Yakutat, Alaska,

FAA Alaskan Region Director Lyle K. Brown announced recently.

The proposed construction calls for a 40 by 125 foot wood paneled utility/storage building and related work to be built in the Yakutat airport area. Estimated cost of the building is between \$25,000 and \$100,000.
