

# **Rural CAP— Fuel Crisis**

In view of the present and future problems related to the energy situation in Alaska, Rural Alaska Community Action Program is co-sponsoring a one-day session aimed at the inflationary aspects of fuel crisis, transportation rates and network, storage facilities, allocation rates, etc. on a statewide basis.

The session can be considered one of an educational encounter between rural consumers and the major oil companies and distributors.

Other co-sponsors will include the Alaska Federation of Natives, Alaska Village Electric Co-op, State Economic Opportunity Office, Community Enterprise Development Corporation and BIA.

Participants have been invited from the Native profit and non-profit corporation, Federal Energy Administration, Older Persons Action League, State Allocation Office and OEO Region X, Union Oil Company and Standard Oil Company of California, with rural villages.

The date will be Sept. 9 in order to give session participants an opportunity to testify as the Federal Energy Administration Public Hearing on energy scheduled for Sept. 9 and 10, and further details will be released later.
