Applicants must supply references regarding work experience with groups of children before initial screening interview.

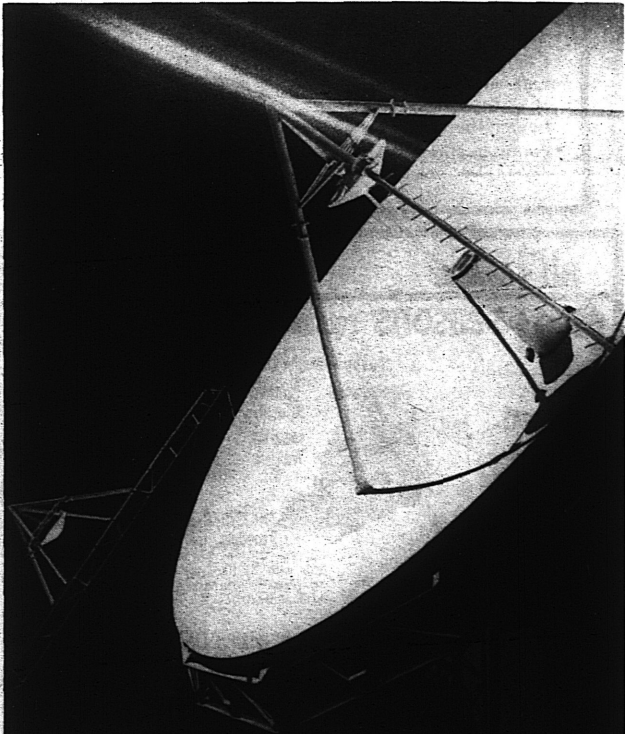
