The conveyance issued for the surface estates of the lands described above shall contain the following reservation to the United States:

Pursuant to Sec. 17(b) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)), the following public lands, hereinafter referred to as "the lands," are hereby conveyed by easement identification number (EIN) on the basis of the attached to this document, copies of which will be found in case file F-14162-EE, are reserved to the United States. All easements are subject to applicable Federal, State, or Municipal Corporation regulation. The following is a listing of uses allowed for each type of easement. Any uses which are not specifically listed are prohibited.

One Acre Site: The uses allowed for a site easement are: vehicle parking (car, aircraft, boat, ATV's, snowmobiles, cars, trucks), temporary campsite, temporary storage of equipment, temporary camping, loading or unloading shall be limited to 24 hours.

a. (EIN 1 C3, C5, D1) An easement for an existing access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from the boundary line of Sec. 5, T. 16 N., R. 13 W., Kotel River Meridian, northeasterly to the east boundary of Sec. 25, T. 16 N., R. 13 W., Kotel River Meridian. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter.

b. (EIN 2 C3, C5, D1) An easement for an existing access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from Sec. 34, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, southeasterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter.

c. (EIN 8 C5, D1) An easement for an existing access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from the boundary line of Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, northeasterly to the boundary line of Sec. 5, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter.

d. (EIN 8a C3, E A one (1) acre high water mark, upland of the ordinary high water mark, Sec. 5, T. 16 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, southeasterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a one (1) acre site.

e. (EIN 8b C4, C5, D1) An easement for an existing access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from the boundary line of Sec. 5, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, southeasterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter.

f. (EIN 12 C5) An easement for a proposed access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from the existing boundary line of Sec. 5, T. 16 N., R. 13 W., Kotel River Meridian, southeasterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement.

g. (EIN 14 C5, D9) An easement for an existing access trail, twenty-five (25) feet in width, from the boundary line of Sec. 35, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, southeasterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter.

The grant of the above-described lands shall be subject to:

1. Issuance of a patent confirming the boundary description of the unpatented lands hereinafter approved after approval and filing by the Bureau of Land Management of the map of survey covering such lands;

2. Valid existing rights therein, if any, including but not limited to those created by any lease (including a lease issued under Sec. 6(a) of the Alaska National Claims Settlement Act, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(g)), contract, permit, or grant to the complete enjoyment of all rights, privileges, and benefits therein granted to him. Further, pursuant to Sec. 17(b)(2) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)(2)) (ANCSA), any valid existing right recognized by ANCSA shall continue to have whatever right of access is now provided for under existing law;

3. Public surface lease F-21411, containing approximately 232.35 acres, located in protracted section 35, T. 17 N., R. 11 W., Kotel River Meridian, issued to the United States by the Department of Public Works, Division of Aviation under the provisions of 47 Stat. 728-729; 49 U.S.C. 211-214); and

4. Requirements of Sec. 14(c) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)), that the grantee hereunder convey those public lands, if any, the surface estate of the lands hereinafter granted, as are prescribed in said section.

NANA Regional Corporation, Inc. is the holder of the public lands entitled to conveyance of 138,240 acres land selected pursuant to Sec. 12(a) (3) of ANCSA. Together with the lands herein approved, the total acreage conveyed or approved for conveyance is approximately 138,240 acres. The remaining entitlement of approximately 11,961 acres will be conveyed at a later date.

Within the above described lands, only the following inland water bodies are considered to be navigable:

The interconnecting sloughs and channels of the Kobuk River.

There are numerous other water bodies and waterways which are influenced. Local information indicates that the range line between 11 W. and 12 W. (Kotel River Meridian) is located within the tidal influence limit. The extent of tidal influence will be determined at the time of survey.

In accordance with Departmental regulation 43 CFR 2650.7(d), notice of this decision is being published once in the FEDERAL REGISTER and once in the TUNDRA Times, and the public is invited to file any party claiming a property interest in lands affected by this decision, an agency of the Federal government or regional corporation may appeal the decision to the Alaska Native Claims Appeal Board, P.O. Box 2433, Anchorage, Alaska 99510 with a copy served upon both the Bureau of Land Management, Alaska State Office, 701 S. Street, Box 13, Anchorage, Alaska 99513 and the Regional Solicitor, Office of the Solicitor, 510 L Street, Suite 408, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. The time limits for filing an appeal are:

1. Parties receiving service of this decision shall have 30 days from the receipt of this decision to file an appeal.

2. Unknown parties, parties unable to be located after reasonable efforts have been expended to locate, and parties who failed or refused to sign the return receipt shall have until AUGUST 22, 1980 to file an appeal.

Any party known or unknown who is adversely affected by this decision shall be deemed to have waived those rights which were adversely affected upon an appeal is filed with the Alaska Native Claims Appeal Board.

To avoid summary dismissal of the appeal, the appellant must comply with the regulations governing such appeals. Further information regarding the regulations for filing an appeal may be obtained from the Bureau of Land Management, Alaska State Office, Box 13, Anchorage, Alaska 99513.

Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act

This decision approves lands near Ambler for conveyance to NANA Regional Corporation, Inc.

On November 14, 1974, NANA Regional Corporation, Inc. filed selected claims for F-19154-9, F-19154-10 and F-19154-11 under the provisions of Sec. 12(c) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(g)) (ANCSA), for the surface and subsurface estates of certain lands described pursuant to Sec. 11(a) (i) of the Native Village of Ambler.

NANA Regional Corporation, Inc. in its application F-19154-9, excluded the following body of water:

Deadened slough of Kobuk River located in T. 19 N., R. 5 E., Kotel River Meridian

Because this water body has been determined to be a deadened slough, it is considered to be public lands available pursuant to Sec. 11(a) (i) and available for conveyance to the grantee pursuant to Sec. 12(c) (3) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.

Section 12(c)(3) and 43 CFR 2652.3(c) provide that the Regional Solicitor shall select the lands available to be reasonably compact if the lands are not selected by the grantee selection within its exterior boundary lines.

For these reasons, the water body which was improperly excluded in its application F-19154-9, NANA Regional Corporation, Inc. is considered selected.

As to the lands described below, the regulations are properly filed and the regulations of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)) are applicable to the lands hereinafter approved.
