



conveyance

The Bureau of Land Management conveyed an additional 1,683 acres to the village of Copper Center August 4 under terms of the Alaska Native Cliams Settlement Act. This action supplements the village's major conveyance which took place in July, bringing total lands conveyed to Copper Center thus far to 104, 100 acres. The subsurface estates was conveved to Ahtna.

The additional acreage is in the vicinity of Copper Center and southeast of the village along the Richardson Highway. Copper Center is one of 8 village corporations within the Ahtna region.
