



EMBLEM—Which gold rush organization can claim this emblem? This original art work of an Alaskan Pioneer organization, displayed by (left) Earl Blinzler, president of the Anchorage, Igloo of the Pioneers of Alaska, and Mayor of Anchorage, Elmer Rasmuson, was discovered in the back room of an antique shop in Seattle. The detailed pencil drawing, elaborately framed, includes

a dog and sled, windlass, gold pick and shovel, salmon, bear, beaver, eagle, Yukon sternwheeler, miner's cabin, Mt. McKinley, the date 1867, and the motto "MUSH ON". "If anyone can identify the art work, and if the organization is still alive, I shall be pleased to present this emblem to the lodge," Rasmuson stated.
