

Board of Fisheries receives 693 proposals for meetings

The Board of Fisheries opened its winter agenda to all finfish fisheries in the state and received 693 proposals, according to the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

Cook Inlet and Southeast fisheries generated 153 and 151 proposals respectively. Virtually every finfish fisheries in the state is represented by one or more of the remaining 389 proposals.

The board will take up the proposals

beginning Nov. 30 to Dec. 3 in the Anchorage Hilton Hotel.

The board will travel to Cordova on Dec. 4, where it will consider Prince William Sound proposals on Dec. 5-6. Members will then travel back to Anchorage on Dec. 7.

The board will meet in the Anchorage Hilton Dec. 8-21. Southeast proposals will be considered Jan. 7-17 in the Sitka Shee Atika Hotel.
