FORT YUKON — The Fort Yukon Eagles and Galena Hawks boys basketball teams split a pair of games in high school action this past weekend in Fort Yukon. Fort Yukon dumped the Hawks on Friday, January 19, by the score of 65-61. On Sa-

turday, the Hawks rallied for a close 66-64 victory.

Darin Michael and Clifton Cadzow with 22 and 18 points respectively led the Eagles to victory on Friday. Michael's effort also earned him game high scoring honors. Galena was led by
