

# **\$10 Disaster Head Tax Due By April 30**

**JUNEAU**—Acting Commissioner George A. Morrison of the Department of Revenue announced last Friday that employers' payments for the state's new disaster relief tax will be due on April 30, 1968, the same deadline for filing state net income tax withholding statements.

Morrison issued the notice in response to inquiries from a number of employers around the state.

The Commissioner said this means of payment of the

disaster tax, which was part of the package approved by the Alaska Legislature in special session in October following the disastrous Tanana Valley flood, "offers the employer the opportunity to deduct the \$10 disaster relief tax from any pay check issued during the first quarter."

Morrison noted, however, that employers are liable for payment of the tax for any persons employed during the quarter.
