All Hunting and Sports Fishing Licenses Invalid New Years Day

As of New Years Day, all 1967 hunting and sports fishing licenses become invalid. Before hunting or fishing in '68, a new license must be purchased.

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game reminds trappers, however, that their licenses are valid until September 30, 1968.

A few game animals can still be taken legally after January 1, reports Frank Jones, southeastern Regional Game Supervisor.

These animals are wolves, wolverine, black bear, brown

bear, hair seal, blue grouse, ptarmigan, and until January 31 on the Panhandle mainland, mountain goat.

Early purchase of your licenses insures that you are ready if and when an opportunity presents itself and, of course, the licenses cost no extra if purchased early.
