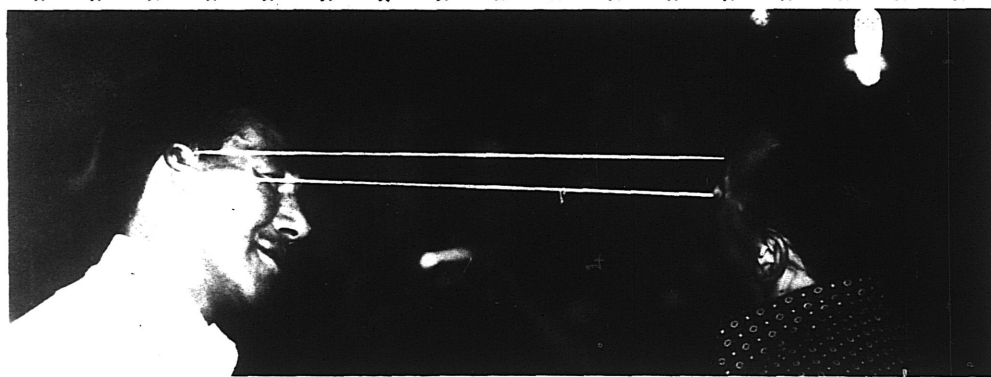
WICHE STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM APPLICANTS

Applications for WICHE Student Exchange Program certification for the 1982-83 academic year are now available from the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education, Director for Special Programs, Pouch F, Juneau, Alaska 99811.

The Student Exchange Program helps Alaska residents obtain access of 16 fields of professional education not available in Alaska, but made available at participating institutions in other western states at a reduced tuition rate. WICHE students may expect preferential admissions consideration from the schools to which they apply. The graduate and professional programs available to Alaska residents are: Architecture, Dentistry, Forestry, Graduate Library Studies, Graduate Nursing, Law, Maritime Technology, Medicine, Occupational Therapy, Optometry, Osteopathy, Pharmacy, Physical Therapy, Podiatry, Public Health, and Veterinary Medicine.

Eligibility for certification is based on at least two continuous years of Alaska residency by the time of entrance into graduate or professional school. Eligible students will receive final certification pending sufficient funding from the State Legislature.

1982-83 applications must be submitted to the Commission office by October 15, 1981. Students applying after the deadline will be placed on alternate status for certification.
