

Research Grant For Fairbanks Ice Fog Problem

FAIRBANKS — The National Science Foundation has awarded a grant to the University of Alaska's Geophysical Institute for research on ice fog in Fairbanks.

The grant, in the amount of \$17,600, will support a project titled "Feasibility of Preventing Ice Fog Formation by Induced Cloud Cover in Fairbanks, Alaska."

Directing the project will be Dr. K.O.L.F. Jayaweera, assistant professor of geophysics for the institute.
