Work will consist of construction of a 100 foot by 200 foot parking apron, a 100 foot by 3,000 foot runway, a 50 foot by 150 foot taxiway and an access road from the village to the airport.

Principal items of work are: Approximately 148,800 tons of borrow embankment, 6,950 tons of aggregate surface course, and other pertinent items for the construction of new airports.

Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project F-093-2(9) Egan Expressway Intersection Improvements, described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, April 1, 1982 in the Claims and Bidding Unit, Second Floor, 6860 Glacier Highway, Juneau, Alaska.

This project will consist of grading, paving, drainage, illumination, signalization, bridge and pedestrian access construction on 2.159 miles of roadway in the Juneau area.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 24,380 tons of Borrow, Type A; 11,300 tons of Crushed Aggregate Base Course; 20,100 tons of Subbase, Grading E; 6,500 tons of Asphalt Concrete Type I; and 390 tons of AC-5 Asphalt Cement.

All work shall be completed in 165 Calendar Days.

In accordance with requirements set forth by the "Federal Highway Administration," the following provisions are made a part of all advertisements for highway construction contracts:

"The Department has established a total Female and Minority Business Enterprise

(FMBE) participation goal of 4.0 percent for this project composed of 3.0 percent for firms owned and controlled by minorities and 1.0 percent for firms owned and controlled by women.

Where no goals are specified for a project, bidders must submit certifications stating whether or not they intend to subcontract a portion of the work and, if so, that they have taken affirmative action to seek out and consider female and minority as potential subcontractors. Each bidder shall submit a completed FMBE Certification, Form 25A320 8/80, attached to the proposal. Proposals will not be considered without a completed Form 25A320 attached.

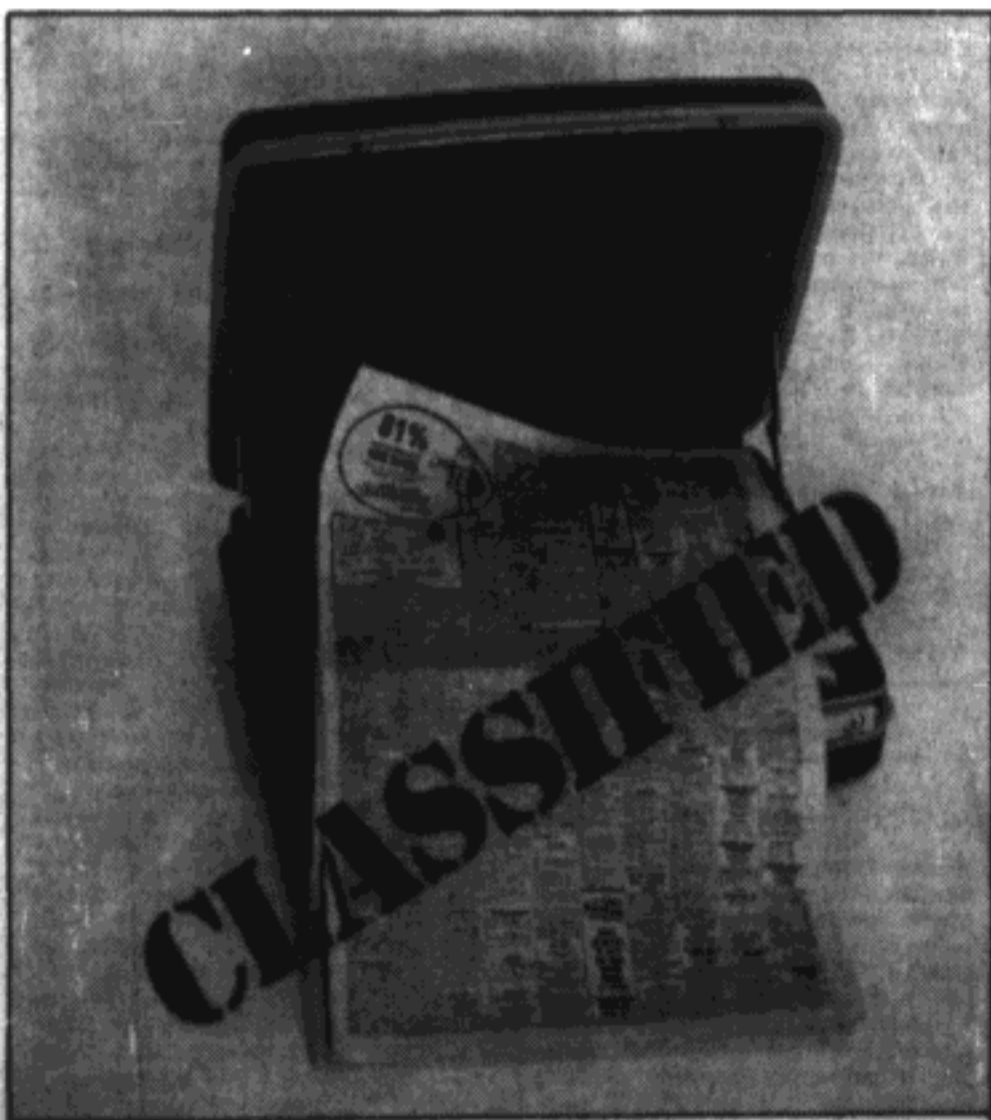
Where percentage goals are specified for a project, bidders must submit a completed Female and Minority Business Enterprise Report, Form 25A326 5/81, attached to the proposal. Proposals will not be considered without a completed Form 25A326 attached." Forms 25A320 or 25A326 will be included with the bidding documents.

Bidders that submit false information or that fail to meet Female and Minority Enterprise Goals and fail to demonstrate sufficient reasonable efforts shall not be eligible to be awarded the contract.
