

Wade to Announce Issues In August

Secretary of State Hugh J. Wade came through Fairbanks this week after attending to election matters in a number of villages in the Kotzebue area.

"I haven't started campaigning," he said. "It's hard to carry on the campaign while still working on election matters."

Incumbent Wade is seeking re-election. He gives the impression that his chief opponent will be James G. Pinkerton of Ketchikan who is

running to unseat him.

"I'm not going to be able to compete with money. I haven't got it," he said.

Wade said he will make known the issues close to the end of the primary.

On his trip through the villages, he said he still found a lot of native people who still remember him from the days when he was Area Director for the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
