Senate Bill 98 Personal Responsibility Act of 1995 sponsored by Senator Green

- deny PFD to anyone who received welfare in previous year
- · no welfare unless U.S. citizen
- · cut AFDC levels
- · cut APA levels
- · require teenage mothers to remain at home
- five year limit on AFDC unless person is totally physically or mentally disabled
- penalty for failure to keep AFDC child or teenage parent in school
- penalty for quitting job if on AFDC
- · require establishment of parentage
- · prohibit AFDC for additional children after one
- allow an additional 6 months of AFDC if recipient marries
- directs DHSS to implement workfare project -- only in urban areas

Note: There are so many areas of drastic change in this bill it may not be Constitutional or allowable under federal law. It is expected to be rewritten shortly. There are few incentives or increased support services.
