This just in . . .

The State Senate Subcommittee of the Select Committee on Legislative Ethics met on October 13, 1993 and deliberated on investigations pending before it. The subcommittee made a finding of probable cause to believe a violation of the ethics law took place in five specific instances involving Senator George Jacko (D-Pedro Bay). The subcommittee determined that corrective actions were not appropriate and sanctions could be needed. Formal charges and a summons were issued to Senator Jacko to respond to the charges within 10 days. A hearing on the matter has been scheduled for November 8 at 9 a.m. at the Legislative Information Office in Anchorage.
