

# Teacher's job fair set

Alaska Teacher's Job Fair will be held in Anchorage March 8-10 at the Captain Cook Hotel. The fair offers an opportunity for teachers and school administrators to discuss job opportunities.

Representatives from approximately 25 school districts are expected to participate in the fair. The individual districts will have group information sessions. These sessions enable job seekers to match their skills and qualifications with the districts' needs. Individual interviews may also be available.

The Alaska Teacher Placement Program of the University of Alaska-Fairbanks will offer group sessions in job-hunting strategy, resume writing skills

and interviewing techniques. Conducting the sessions will be Bob Egan of UAF's Career Planning and Placement.

With a teacher turnover rate of 20 percent, Alaska has about 1,000 teaching openings annually. At the Job Fair, many superintendents will be able to discuss some of their anticipated openings with fair participants.

The annual fair is held in conjunction with the Alaska Chapter of the National Education Association's annual convention.
