

Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey was picked for the Democratic nominee for President of the United States in the general election in November by the Democratic National Convention in Chicago last Wednesday night.

The Vice President gained his vote for nomination on landslide proportions over his closest opponent Senator Eugene McCarthy of Minnisota.
