## Management Positions Open

Nancy Chamberlain, director of the Human Resource Department for Calista Corporation, is now taking new applications for the ongoing Sheraton Anchorage Management Train-

ing program.

Ms. Chamberlain said, "Applicants should be dedicated and willing to learn new procedures. They should be willing to make

a year-long commitment to the training program and have a high school or equivalent education."

A statewide recruitment is now underway with emphasis on the Calista Region. The program is open to Alaskan Natives and American Indians only. After a classroom training period the trainees will be assigned to a variety of trainee positions at the Sheraton Anchorage Hotel.

Possible positions to be open to trainees include director of security trainee, front office assistant manager trainee, housekeeping supervisor trainee, food and beverage trainee, sales manager trainee, assistant chief

engineer trainee, assistant controller trainee, executive steward trainee and chief telephone operator trainee. A total of four to five positions will be awarded to applicants.

Wages vary from \$3.85 to \$6.50 per hour depending on the position to be filled at the Sheraton Anchorage Hotel. Classroom training will start in late April and on-the-job trainee positions will be filled in the latter part of May.
