

## **Alaskans Eligible For National Crafts Exhibit**

Alaskan craftspeople are invited to participate in the League of New Hampshire Craftsmen's JUBILEE 50 EXHIBIT which will feature the most creative, skillfully executed, and visually stimulating traditional and nontraditional crafts being made in the United States today.

Up to 300 pieces will be selected by the panel of jurors: Jonathan Fairbanks, Curator of Decorative Arts, Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; Star Miller Sacks, owner of the Hand and Spirit Gallery, Scottsdale, Arizona; and Sylvia Ullman, owner of the American Craftsmen Galler, Cleveland, Ohio.

Craftspeople may enter up to three 35mm slides of work executed in the past two years that have not been exhibited east of the Mississippi. Slides must be received no later than February 6, 1981.
