NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Notice is given that the State Board of Education, under authority of AS 14.07.060 proposes to amend regulations in Title 4 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with teacher certification fees to implement AS 14.20.020(c) and AS 12.62.030(f), as follows:

4 AAC 12.010(g) is proposed to be amended to clarify that the fee for a criminal history background check is in addition to the fee charged for a teacher certificate.

4 AAC 12.010(h) is proposed to be amended to allow the Department of Education to change the fee for the criminal history background check to the fee amount charged by the Department of Public Safety (DPS) as set out in 13 AAC 25.400. Currently DPS charges \$40 for a background check and has announced a fee increase to \$43 on or about October 1, 1990.
