Notice of Hazardous Operations
The University of Alaska, Geophysical Institute will be launching high altitude rockets from the Poker Flat Launch Site vicinity, Mile 30 Steese Highway (Chatanika) during the period November 15, through December 15, 1973, at the hours of sun set to sun rise plus or minus 2 hours. The danger zone includes the pie shaped area formed by lines bearing clockwise 359° true through 010° true from the Poker Flat Launch Site, extending 175 nautical miles north of the launch site, plus that area formed by a circle 1 mile in radius around the launcher, and from the surface to 60,000 feet altitude overlying these areas.
