Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project A.I.P. 83-1-3-0201-330183, Juneau Seaplane Float described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, July 14, 1983 in the First Floor Conference Room, Room 101, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of installation of a new eight (8) ramp seaplane facility. The existing ramps, gangway and gangway approach and related items will be removed. This will be replaced with a new 6,000 square foot timber float and ramps, a steel gangway and a treated timber approach.

Other items on the project include 3,006 cubic yards of excavation; 935 linear feet of treated timber piles, furnished; 15 each treated timber piles, driven; an electrical system (lighting and power pedestals); a water system (6-inch diameter D.I. extension, a fire hydrant,

1 inch water service and related appurtenances) and 2 each fire extinguishers and cabinet.

The Engineer's Estimate is between \$250,000 and \$500,000.

All work shall be completed by December 1, 1983.

In accordance with requirements set forth by the "Federal Aviation Administration," the following provisions are made a part of all advertisements for aviation construction contracts:

"The Department has established a total Female and Minority Business Enterprise (FMBE) participation goal of 4.0 percent for this project composed of 3.0 percent for firms owned and controlled by minorities and 1.0 percent for firms owned and controlled by women.

Proposals will not be considered without a completed Form 25A326 attached. Form 25A326 will be included with the bidding documents."

Bidders that submit false information or that fail to meet Female and Minority Enterprise Goals and fail to demonstrate sufficient reasonable efforts shall not be eligible to be awarded the contract.
