

Journalism fellowship available

A journalism fellowship is a sabbatical from deadlines, an escape from the newsroom. Each year, twelve professionals from print and broadcast journalism are awarded Knight Fellowships at Stanford University. They pursue an academic year of study, intellectual growth, and personal change.

The program seeks applicants who have demonstrated uncom-

mon excellence in their work and who have the potential of reaching the top ranks in their specialization. All full-time journalists in news/editorial work are eligible. Up to two fellowships may be awarded to those in business/management positions.

Applications are encouraged from members of ethnic minorities. Candidates must have seven years of professional experience.

Fellows receive a stipend of \$35,000 plus tuition and a book allowance. All academic and social benefits are open to spouses of Fellows.
