The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that an
application (Docket U-94-113) has been filed by AT&T CORP. (AT&T), to acquire a control-
ling interest in ALASCOM, INC. (Alascom), a wholly owned subsidiary of Pacific telecom,
Inc. Alascom holds Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (Certificate) No. 98,
authorizing it to provide telecommunications (intrastate interexchange) public utility service
throughout the State of Alaska. AT&T has previously acquired a controlling interest in the
following telecommunications utilities: Radio Communications, Inc. (Certificate No. 413);
McCaw/Rock Seward Cable Systems (Certificate No. 367); and has a financial interest in
McCaw/Rock Homer Cable System (Certificate No. 401).

Pursuant to AS 42.05.491, AT&T has requested that Alascom be allowed to
keep its records outside the state of Alaska, at AT&T's Headquarters at 295 N. Maple
Avenue, Basking Ridge, NJ 07920 or at 795 Folsom Street, San Francisco, CA 94107.

According to the Application, Alascom's current tariff will continue to be in effect
with this acquisition.
