

Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program

The ALASKA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION (AHFC) announces the availability of federal FY93 and FY94 funding for the Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program (ORP). Funds are available to non-profit organizations or public agencies selected by AHFC to act as a "subrecipient" to administer AHFC's ORP. Using funds provided by AHFC, subrecipients then provide, and administer, grant funds to eligible low-income families for the purpose of rehabilitating or improving their owner-occupied dwelling. Properties to be rehabilitated or improved must be located outside of the Municipality of Anchorage.

Eligible applicants include only public agencies or non-profit organizations.

If selected by AHFC, successful offerors must execute a Subrecipient Agreement and administer the funds in accordance with Federal HOME Program Regulations and AHFC's ORP Program Policies and Procedures Manual.

Applications for funding under this program must be received by 5 p.m. ADT, February 15, 1995. Proposals received after the deadline or delivered to an incorrect AHFC location before the deadline WILL NOT be considered for funding. Telefax applications WILL NOT be accepted. The original proposal and three (3) copies should be sent to the name and address noted above.
