

State Scholarship Loan Program

JUNEAU—Governor William A. Egan announced that 959 Alaskan students have been awarded \$1.5 million in loans under the State's new scholarship loan program.

"The awarding of these loans has not utilized all the funds provided by the 1971 Legislature," the Governor said. "I am highly pleased that this large number of young Alaskans have been able to take advantage of this assistance program to help

them obtain an education."

Small amounts of money will become available during the school year due to withdrawals, dropouts and cancellations, the Governor said, and this will be re-issued to students in the order that additional applications were received.

Of the scholarship loans awarded, 517 of the students are attending Alaska colleges and 442 are attending colleges outside.
