Fink, Mystrom face each other in Oct. 30 runoff for mayor

Anchorage Mayor Tom Fink and Rick Mystrom will face each other in a runoff Oct. 30 as a result of the election Tuesday in which neither candidate garnered the required 40 percent of the vote needed to win. Fink got 38.6 percent of the vote with 20,956 votes, while Mystrom got 38.4 percent with 20,813 votes.

The third candidate in the race, H.A. "Red" Boucher got 20.9 percent of the vote with 11,358 votes.
