

Five-day substance abuse conference targets youth

NORMAN, OKLA. — A five-day conference on substance abuse prevention for American Indians will be sponsored by the University of Oklahoma's Health, Urban and Community Programs Nov. 26-30 at the Del Mar Hilton Hotel in San Diego, Calif.

The objective of the conference — "Indian Teen Power: Mobilizing Our Youth Against Substance Abuse" — is to assist professionals who work with Indian youth in formulating community action plans to prevent alcohol and drug problems.

The conference's target audience in-

cludes drug and alcohol counselors, health educators, youth program staffers, school officials and teachers, tribal leaders and council members, as well as community health representatives.

The cost of the conference is \$60, which does not include the cost of the room.
