Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project F-037-2(23), Anchorage - Fairbanks Highway, Cantwell, 1-mile North described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, January 18, 1973 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of grading and drainage on 1.2 miles of roadway located near Cantwell, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 16 acres of clearing and grubbing; 13,000 cubic yards of unclassified excavation; 102,600 tons of borrow; 10,700 tons of subbase "C"; 576 linear feet of 24" pipe conduit; 353,000 square feet of 1" diameter electrical conduit; and miscellaneous items of work.

All work shall be completed in 184 calendar days.
