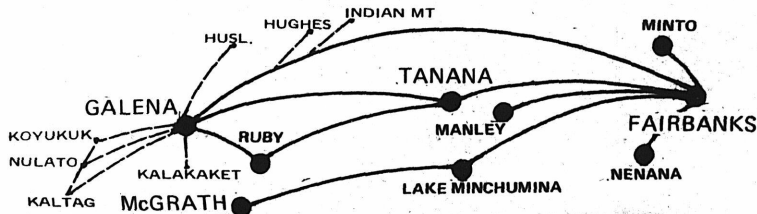

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

Notice is hereby given that the ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, under authority vested by AS 42.05.151(a), pursuant to a petition submitted under AS 44.62.220 by the Council for Economic Justice, the Alaska Public Interest Research Group, 11 other groups and 16 individuals, proposes to amend a regulation in Title 3 of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement and make specific AS 42.05.141 and AS 42.05.401(a), as follows:

3 AAC.48.430 is amended by adding a new sentence to provide that the February, 1971, edition of the Separations Manual published by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC), commonly known as the "Ozark Plan", would be used for the "purpose of establishing settlements in Alaska but need not necessarily be used for the purpose of establishing intrastate toll rates" charged by long lines carriers.

Notice is also given that any person interested may present oral or written statements or arguments relating to the action proposed at a hearing to be held in accordance with AS 44.62.200 and AS 44.62.230, at the Commission offices, 1100 MacKay Building, 338 Denali Street, Anchorage, Alaska, at 10 a.m., Friday October 27. To expedite review of the proposed amended regulation, the Commission requests that written comments be filed by 4:30 p.m., Wednesday, October 25, 1978.

Copies of the proposed amended regulation may be obtained by writing the Commission, at the above address, or from the petitioners, P.O. Box 1093, Anchorage, Alaska 99510.

The Alaska Public Utilities Commission upon its own motion, or at the request of any interested person, may at the hearing or after it adopt the proposal substantially as described above without further notice; may amend it prior to adoption, or may decide to take no action on it.
